

Mr Masashi Takemura, Managing Director, MDSI (HK) Limited MDSI (HK) Limited 董事總經理 竹村匡史先生

It is a subsidiary company of Designphil which is a design company specialized in both product design and commercial design, and MDS which is one of the companies with the highest sales volume of stationery in Japan, sourcing products from more than 400 stationery manufacturers; supplying to first-class retailers, department stores, and specialty stores in Japan.



Mr Masashi Takemura is a renowned expert in Design Stationery in Asian Market. He joined SEIBU Department Store after graduating from the SOKA University with a Bachelor Degree of Labor Economics and became the Chief Stationery Buyer of Seibu and the General Manager of Hong Kong SEIBU LOFT a few years later. Mr Takemura was one of the founders and Executive Director of Citysuper (HK) Ltd. He had also worked for the Talee ISETAN and Datong Department Store as General Manager.

Being the Managing Director of MDSI (HK) Ltd. now, Mr Takemura manages the company business in HK where the head office is located. The head office is responsible for developing the company's international market network as well as building the QIPS brand (Quest for Innovative Personal Style). QIPS-branded stationery carries the essence of unique Japanese workmanship and design style. The office is now actively seeking potential developments.

Korea Stationery Industry cooperative (KSIC) was established in 1962 with the objectives to direct sound development of Korea stationary industry and improve welfare of members as well as assist member's self-independent economic activity by participating in the activities of the cooperative association. Currently, there are over 360 stationery manufacturers in Korea being its member companies.



Mr Shin Gun Sik was graduated from the Chung-Ju University with Trade & Economy being his major area of study. He has been working for the Korea Stationery Industry cooperative for over 27 years, taking charge of the organisation's foreign affairs. He organises the Seoul International Stationery Fair (SISFAIR) and participates in the Korea pavilion with the government support.
